

While 2020 was fraught with challenges, we were heartened by the passion and perseverance of the preservationists we support. Idaho Heritage Trust granted \$136,550 to 23 projects across 18 counties, which helped enable our grantees to raise an additional \$463,230 in matching funds to complete their projects. In addition, we provided \$53,500 in Technical Assistance for architectural, engineering, and conservation consultation. A list of grants and grantees appears on the following page, as well as a map highlighting each project site. Of particular note is the grant to replace the siding of Our Lady of Tears church overlooking Silver City, as well as the structural assessment we provided to help shape the restoration process of the Gold Point Mill near Elk City. Additionally, 2020 saw the completion of the reroofing project at the ever-popular **Johnny Sacks** Cabin, which was funded by a grant awarded in 2018.

We are also thrilled to report that we have completed work on a **brand-new Idaho Heritage Trust website** (idahoheritagetrust.org). It features an Interactive Map, which can be organized and searched by county or town, so you can find some neat historical sites in your own backyard or use it to plan some stops on your next road trip. You can also learn more about our organization and the services we provide, meet our board of trustees, and keep up on a bevy of news and information about the impact and importance of historical preservation projects on the community, the economy, and our collective culture. It is also home to some excellent educational material, from technical reference guides and educational videos to a series of articles touching on a variety of interesting topics related to Idaho's storied history. The Idaho Heritage Trust is honored to provide leadership and funding to aid individual communities with the restoration and maintenance of what makes them so special. The majority of the more than nearly 600 projects we have helped support has gone to communities of fewer than 5,000 people and help support such integral institutions like our historic courthouses and theaters, iconic churches that form the fabric of our beloved downtowns, and many more unique pieces of Idaho's past that still make an indelible impression on our daily lives.
